TAKE CARE OF OUR TUMMIES

When switching to Rival cat food from another cat food, allow 7 to 10 days for the transition. Mix increasing amounts of Rival cat food with decreasing amounts of your cat's previous food until you are feeding only Rival cat food.

FOR THE EXPECTANT CAT

Food consumption may vary throughout gestation and lactation. During gestation, feed the amount necessary to maintain the weight of the pregnant female. During lactation, feed 2 to 4 times normal intake. Use the chart at right as a guide to feed cats daily.

INGREDIENTS

Chicken, Water sufficient for processing, Meat by-products, Chicken by-products, Beef, Fish, Liver, Wheat middling, Carrageenan, Salt, Cassia, Guar gum, Potassium chloride, Taurine, Red oxide, Choline chloride, Garlic powder, Zinc sulfate, Niacin supplement, Ferrous sulfate, Vitamin E supplement, Thiamine mononitrate, Manganese sulfate, D-pantothenic acid, Copper sulfate, Pyridoxine hydrochloride, Riboflavin supplement, Vitamin A supplement, Folic acid, Potassium iodide, Sodium selenite, Biotin, Vitamin B12 supplement, Vitamin D3 supplement.

FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

For adult cats, feed 1 can daily per 6 pounds of body weight. For kittens, feed 1/2 can to 3/4 can 2-3 times daily per 6 pounds of body weight. Provide plenty of clean, fresh water at all times.
